Actions:

After School Clubs – we understand that you may feel we don't offer a wide enough choice of clubs. We try to ensure that over the full school year we offer as many different clubs as possible, however, in order to maintain the quality of these clubs we have to select our providers very carefully. This is the reason that several of our clubs are run by teachers on a voluntary basis as the quality is then assured. Our Sports Skills club has become a favourite and I hope to run this again in the future. This year we also offered Circurama which we last offered some years ago and again it has proved very popular. We will continue to explore options for future years.

Extended Services – this is now a hugely popular part of the school offer and again we continue to try and meet all needs. At present we seem to be able to accommodate most children in Breakfast Club although occasionally we have had no spaces left in After School Care. We continue to assess the need and if requests for places continue to rise then we may be able to offer more places in the future. We are also assessing whether or not we will need to charge you if you book a place (particularly on our busy evenings) and then somebody collects your child as we may have turned another child down. However if you let us know in advance we can usually offer the place to someone else.

Communication – we always aim to be flexible about Parent Consultations and will do our best to rearrange an appointment to suit you. We understand that you may be working and unable to come during the times we arrange but staff will do their best to speak to you in person or on the phone during their lunchtime or before school. Please just call and let us know if you have not been able to speak to the teacher about your child's progress and you wish to do so.
