	English	Maths	Phonics	Topic
Monday	Write some news about your Easter Activities. Remember to answer the “nosy words” when you write, e.g <u>What</u> did you do? <u>Who</u> did you do it with? <u>Where</u> did you go? <u>Why?</u> <u>When?</u> https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-l-616-my-news-writing-template	Practise counting in 2's today. Jump and as your feet land, count 2,4,6... Money: can you make a shop with ‘even’ prices? Use 2p to pay for items, practise counting in 2's as you do!	Recap the sound and spelling “ ay ”. Think of some words which have the sound- (they can be real or fake!). Try to spell them using your “phoneme fingers”, your grown-ups will help you. Can you write 3 of the words in sentences?	If you can, find some different coloured plants and flowers from your garden. Arrange them nicely between 2 pieces of paper. Put some heavy books on top until tomorrow to “press” them, then check out your work!
Tuesday	Draw a character from your favourite story, or make up your own character and write a description of them. Use adjectives to make your sentences interesting, eg. <u>Long, sharp</u> teeth, <u>smelly brown</u> fur...	Practise counting in 5's today. High five someone in your house as you count 5,10,15... Money: How many ways can you make 10p? using 1p,2p,5p. Can you draw how you make it?	Recap the sound and spelling “ ou ”. Think of some words which have the sound- (they can be real or fake!). Try to spell them using your “phoneme fingers”, your grown-ups will help you. Can you write 3 of the words in sentences?	Today is the Queen's Birthday! Can you design her a birthday card and write it out to her?
Wednesday	Draw a setting for your character to live in e.g (forest, outer space, jungle, Antarctic), and describe it. Remember capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. Try to use adjectives to make your sentences interesting, eg. “at the top of a <u>tall</u> tree in the <u>hot</u> jungle...”	Practise counting in 10's today. Put your two hands up as you count 10,20,30... Play the Piggy Bank game: https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-n-1278-how-much-money-is-in-my-piggy-bank-powerpoint-quiz	Practise reading the words “ oh ”, “ their ” and “ people ”. Can you have a go to spell them and write them in sentences?	Can you name the parts of a flowering plant? Draw a picture and label the parts including (roots, stem, leaves, flowers) Take a photo of your work and send them to facebook or parentshare.
Thursday	Fold some paper into 3 sections to make a “storyboard” with a beginning/ middle/ end. Draw a picture in each section to show what will happen in each part of the story. Write a caption under each part.	You choose which counting to practise! Have a go at the St Georges problems: https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-n-2544917-st-georges-day-maths-challenge-cards-1	Recap the sound and spelling “ ie ”. Think of some words which have the sound- (they can be real or fake!). Try to spell them using your “phoneme fingers”, your grown-ups will help you. Can you write 3 of the words in sentences?	Today is St George's Day! Can you find out about him on the internet? https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-t-5489-st-georges-day-story-powerpoint Draw a picture of George and the Dragon!
Friday	Use your ideas from this week to write a story about your character. What will your story opener be? Remember to make it interesting and use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.	You choose which counting to practise! Can you make a shop and practise paying for items using a mixture of 1p, 2p and 5p coins? How many different combinations of items can you buy?	Recap the sound and spelling “ ea ”. Think of some words which have the sound- (they can be real or fake!). Try to spell them using your “phoneme fingers”, your grown-ups will help you. Can you write 3 of the words in sentences?	Can you find some seeds in a piece of your fruit? Pop them in a pot with some soil from the garden. Can you help it to grow? What will the seed need? Keep a diary to see what happens!
