








Weeks beginning 6th and 13th July 2020 - Reception Challenge Activity Grid - Alien Tea on Planet Zum Zee

<p>Next week on Thursday 16th July we are going to have an alien tea party on afternoon. The activities we have planned over the next 2 weeks relate to this activity.</p>	English	Maths	Phonics	Topic					
<p>Monday</p>	<p>Our book for the next fortnight is "Alien Tea on Planet Zum Zee"</p>  <p>Share the book with a grown up today. Talk about which part is your favourite and why. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=CAaNP1cCAPQ</p>	<p>We are thinking about weight and capacity. We are going to use the words heavy, light, heavier, lighter, heaviest, lightest. Full, empty, nearly full, nearly empty, half full, half empty. Today In some water - the bath, a water tray, the sink, a bowl of water. Can you use some containers and see if you make them full, empty, half full, nearly empty. Tell a grown up how much water is in them.</p>	<p>Have a go at playing this Obb and Bob phase 4 game on phonics bloom. https://www.phonicsbloom.com/uk/game/odd-and-bob?phase=4</p>	<p>Today we are going to find out about the solar system and the planets. Do you know the names of any of them? Can you find some facts out about the planets? Can you think of a way to remember all of their names?</p>					
<p>Tuesday</p>	<p>Today you need to think about the story and pick out something that happened. Can you have a go at painting or drawing a picture about it and writing some sentences?</p>	<p>Today In a muddle capacity activity .Work with a grown up. Read the captions. Can you match the drinks to the correct person?</p>	<p>Today you could have a go at writing some words in the phoneme frames. You can choose anyway of making them. In school we are going to use paper and do some marbling, or bubble painting.</p>
<p>Wednesday</p>	<p>Today we are going to make a list of foods that we could eat at an alien tea party that we are going to have next week. What should we have to eat at the tea party? Talk to a grown up about your ideas and make a list.</p> 	<p>Today gather some containers. Gather a smaller container. How many of the smaller containers do you think it would take to fill the larger one? Tell your grown up your guess and then check. Maybe you could get another container to fill - do you think it will take more or less?</p>	<p>Use the phase 4 captions saved on the blog and see if you can read them. Remember to read every word.</p>	<p>Do you have any other alien story books? - Aliens love underpants etc. If you do you could look at the aliens in them. Can you design your own alien? What does your alien look like?</p>					
<p>Thursday</p>	<p>Use the list of party foods that you made yesterday. Can you write a shopping list of what you would need to buy to make some of them?</p>	<p>Today we are thinking about weight and whether an object is heavy and light. Ask your grown up to write the words heavy and light on separate pieces of paper. Can you find some things that are heavy and some things that are light and put them with the correct words?</p>	<p>Today you could play this sentence substitution game on phonics bloom. https://www.phonicsbloom.com/uk/game/sentence-substitution?phase=4</p>	<p>If you have any paper plates you could make a spaceship and this moving alien picture.</p>  					
<p>Friday</p>	<p>Today we are going to design an invitation to invite your friend to the alien tea party. Remember you need to write who it is to, where the party is at, when it is and what time.</p>	<p>Today your grown up will give you an object. Can you find something that is heavier than it and something that is lighter than it? If you have some balance scales you could see that happens when you put the objects in. Talk about what you think will happen when you put the object in.</p>	<p>Can you read the phase 4 alien words? They can be accessed on the blog Or you could play the Obb and Bob game from Monday</p>	<p>Today we have a split pin astronaut for you to cut out carefully. Can you fix the pieces together?</p>

Monday	Talk to your grown up about party games you could play at the tea party. Write a list of party games to play at the party.	Gather 8 objects - Can you order the objects from lightest to heaviest. If you would like to you could use the pictures uploaded to the blog and cut and stick them into the correct order.	https://www.phonicsbloom.com/uk/ga/me/alien-escape?phase=4 Today you need to spell the words to help the alien escape!	Science experiment Bouncing planets - see download on blog  Method 1. Show the children some pictures of each planet and talk about the different colours and sizes of each planet. 2. Choose a planet that you would like to make and decide what colours you will need. 3. Mix a cup of baking soda with about 2 1/2 cups of water. 4. Add your choice of colours to the mixture. 5. Try putting the plate together to form the shape of the planet. If it is too runny, add some more baking soda. If it is too runny, add some more water. 6. Once you have made your choice of planets you can let the bubbling begin. 7. Put the planets on a plate and using the egg dropper/pipette, start dripping vinegar onto the planet. 8. Watch as the planet starts to wobble. You will need: Baking soda Liquid watercolours / food colouring (various colours depending on what planet you choose to do) Water Vinegar Egg dropper / pipette Plates: White Plate
Tuesday	Make and play a game of 'Pin the nose on the alien' Write a list of instructions - how to play pin the nose on the alien. Remember to use Bossy Verbs and tell the people what to do.	Today we are going to bake an alien cake. We need to follow the recipe and weigh our ingredients carefully. You might want to do some preparation for your tea party games today - maybe some aliens for alien hoopla? Or Create an alien and some noses for pin the nose on the alien game. 
Wednesday	Today could you make some alien or star biscuits and write a recipe of how to make them 	Make alien jelly for the tea party - following instructions and measuring water to make the jelly. Discuss how we make it set and the changes that you think will occur. 	You could play the alien blending game today. Can you read the alien words?	Today we are going to make some planet crispy cakes in school. Marshmallow crispy bites 45 grams butter 300 grams mini marshmallows 180 grams rice krispies edible glitter or sprinkles (optional) METHOD Melt the butter in a large, heavy-based saucepan over a low heat. 1. Add the marshmallows and cook gently until they are completely melted and blended, stirring constantly. 2. Take the pan off the heat and immediately add the cereal, mixing lightly until well coated. 3. Allow the mixture to cool enough so you can handle it but that it is still malleable. If the mixture is too sticky, rub your fingers with some butter. 4. Let the marshmallow crispy bites cool completely in the tin.
