	Morning	Letters and Sounds	Afternoon
<b>Monday</b>	<p>This week we are reading Owl Babies by Martin Waddell. You can find a read aloud version here:  <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=8IOaE-77hM">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=8IOaE-77hM</a></p> <p>Listen to story and talk about what happens. Encourage your child to join in with the repetitive parts and ask them questions such as:            Where did the owls live?            How many owls were there and what were their names?            Why were they worried when their mother was gone?</p>	<p>This week we are introducing 'digraphs' – this is where two letters represent one sound eg: ch in ch-i-p</p> <p>Today we are learning 'ch'            Use the resources we have sent you via Active Learn Bug Club</p>	<p>This week during our topic session we are learning about nocturnal animals. We are going to use the internet to find out answers to some questions – this helps the children to understand that information can be derived from computers. So, have a google and see if you can find some interesting facts together! Then draw a picture of an animal you have found out about. You could send us a video of your child telling us something about it!            (We will be looking at bats, foxes and badgers &amp; googling things such as: where do they live? What do they eat)</p>
<b>Tuesday</b>	<p>This week is all about circles and triangle in our maths sessions, along with some extra counting practise. See if you can find examples of these shapes around your house and talk about them, pointing out that circles have no corners and are round. Triangles have 3 sides and 3 corners, their sides are straight. Let your child have a go at the shape owl we have added to the blog – cut around the circles and triangles and try to arrange them to make an owl picture.</p>	<p>Today we are learning 'sh'            Use the resources we have sent you via Active Learn Bug Club</p>	<p>Today we are making nocturnal animal collages. Can you make your own picture of a nocturnal creature and send us a picture?</p> 
<b>Wednesday</b>	<p>Wednesday is now our 1 to 1 reading time where each child will read to their teacher.            Share your child's reading book with them – you will find it here:  <a href="http://www.activelearnprimary.co.uk">www.activelearnprimary.co.uk</a> – log in with your personal details (they are saved in your child's dojo portfolio if you cannot remember them)</p>	<p>Today we are learning 'th'            Use the resources we have sent you via Active Learn Bug Club</p>	<p>This week we are also talking about the changing seasons, and signs of winter. Ask your child about what they know happens in winter. What type of weather do we see? What type of clothes do we need to wear?            Have a go at drawing a picture of yourself wearing some winter clothes.</p>
<b>Thursday</b>	<p>Re-read or listen to the story 'Owl Babies' again to refresh your child's memory. Cut out the stick puppets we have added to our blog and let your child use them to act out the main parts of the story.            Can you draw a picture of something from the story and write some labels or a sentence about it?</p>	<p>Today we are learning 'ng'            Use the resources we have sent you via Active Learn Bug Club</p>	<p>Can you paint or draw a winter scene?</p> 
<b>Friday</b>	<p>Practise counting together. Can your child count forward and backwards to and from 10? 20?            Play 'What am I? – Circle or triangle?' – your child must listen to the information and draw the corresponding shape on some paper Eg: you say 'I have straight sides, what am I?' (child to draw a triangle)</p>	<p>Today recap all of the sounds you know so far including those we have learned this week. Can you read or write some 3 sound words using the digraphs:</p>	<p>This afternoon we will begin learning about the Nativity story, and talking about why Baby Jesus was a special baby. You can watch a video version of the story here:</p>
