



# Reception Learning Grid

<b>Tuesday</b>	<p>We are still developing our understanding of numbers 1,2 and 3.                      Prepare a set of dot plates or cards which have 1,2 or 3 dots in different arrangements.                      Hold up the plates and ask the children how many dots.
