Theme – Once Upon A Time ...

The text that we are using this week is ...

Goldilocks and the Three Bears.

In Letters and Sounds we are going to ...

*Sing the rhyme – When Goldilocks went to the house of the bears ... my singing voice isn't good enough for publication so I've found a video here ...

*We are going to use the rhyme 'One, two buckle my shoe' and encourage children to predict the rhyming words in each verse eg. One two buckle my ..., three, four knock on my ..., five, six pick up seven eight, lay them, nine, ten, I see a"

*We are going to clap the syllables of words from the story of Goldilocks and the three bears, using the picture cards as prompts. Goldilocks (3) The three bears (3) In the woods (3) porridge (2) Bowls of porridge – I would break this up into each word bowls (1) of (1) porridge(2).

* We are going to pretend to be the characters from the story and use different voices for each character.

*we are going to make sounds using instruments to accompany us telling the story (see the story plan on downloads)

Can you retell the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears using the masks?

Can you remember what happened in the right order?

How do you think Goldilocks felt?

How did the bears feel?

In maths we are going to talk about the size of the bears. We are going to sort a selection of teddies into 3 groups – big, medium and small. Can you sort some of your toys into groups and send me a photo? There is also a sorting activity that you could do – sorting images from the story into the three groups. Can you do some sorting and send me a photo?

As we act the story out we are going to talk about how the different characters will move and the differences between each of the Bears.

The big daddy bear will move slower than the baby bear who will run fast.

How do you think Goldilocks moved through the woods – can you skip? run?

Jump over the tree roots?

We are going to explore mixing colours today and have a go at making our own shades of brown using paints today and then we are going to try to paint 3 bears.

Can you try drawing / painting / making 3 bears – remember you need a big, medium and small one.

This week on Wednesday in our cooking session we are going to make and eat some porridge, just like the bears were going to eat. We are going to have different toppings to try in our porridge to see if we like it including berries, honey, jam, marmite, tomato ketchup.
