Monday	Last week we began thinking about the main character in our new class story and predicting what we thought it would be about. This week we are going to read the story! The skills we build up this week will lead to our 'big write' at the end of the week which will be a character description of Eliot Midnight Superhero.  *Remember in all of your writing to include Capital letters, finger spaces and punctuation! *  Eliot Midnight Superhero - YouTube (You can listen to the book on this you tube link)  After you have read the book we would like you to think about how you could describe Eliot's personality. For example: quiet, brave, intelligent, secretive, helpful, fast, talented, sleuth, courageous.  (See Monday dated worksheets)  Task One: Create a mind map of adjectives to describe Eliot's personality.  Task Two: Once you have finished this we would like you think of synonyms for these adjectives. Synonyms are words which have a similar meaning for example: little, small, tiny, teensy. The midnight superhero climbs like \_\_\_\_\_\_because he needs to save people.




